



Veterans Healthcare Enrollment Program

ASPIN uses certified Navigators dually trained as community health workers to support enrollment in health care coverage; to facilitate outreach events; and provide education to improve health and insurance literacy.

Navigators can help enroll Hoosier veterans and their families in both Federal Marketplace plans and State Health Care options, such as HIP 2.0 anywhere using secure and convenient mobile office technology.

ASPIN Health Navigator Program FREE Services include:

- Enroll veterans and family members in Federal Marketplace plans, Medicaid, HIP 2.0 or CHIP
- Assist enrollees with questions about healthcare coverage
- Mobile Navigators for enrollments in public locations
- Assist in updating insurance profiles

Children's Health Insurance Plan (CHIP)

- Offers free or low-cost health insurance for children and teens up to age 18.
- Children can get regular check-ups, immunizations, doctor visits, hospital care, mental health services, prescriptions and more. Children's dental services are covered, too.
- Children in a family of four earning up to \$60,750 a year or more may qualify.
- Those eligible for CHIP or Medicaid can enroll any day of the year.

Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP 2.0) Eligibility Criteria

- Indiana residents ages 19-64
- Income up to \$16,590 annually for individual; \$22,371 for a couple; \$33,934 for a family of four
- Not eligible for Medicare or other Medicaid categories
- HIP Plus & Basic – Each covers medical expenses such as doctor visits, hospital care, therapies, medications, prescriptions and medical equipment. HIP Plus offers best value, and unlike HIP Basic, also covers vision and dental care.
